**VISION:** To internationally evolutionize worship arts from the studio to the stage, screen, to STARDOM.

**MISSION:** To passionately inspire and transform youth worship artists into leaders and successful performers.

**OBJECTIVE:** Provide scholarships and mentoring to students who wish to attend Trinity Conservatory of Performing Arts training classes and workshops but are not able to meet the financial requirements. This mentor program is designed to partner with local non-profit organizations to provide students ages 10-16 with performing arts training classes, leadership development, academic support, and college/career preparation.

When a student graduates from "Y.E.S." they will acquire:

- positive self-image and esteem
- enhanced emotional and physical health
- leadership skills to complete successful individual and collaborative projects
- stage and screen performance skills
- improved academic achievement
- resume and college prepared packet to enroll into a University

The applicant must need financial assistance based on the following qualifications:

- low socioeconomic status (see attached parental salary scale)
- a desire to acquire the skills necessary to reach full potential and goals in the arts
- attending school lacks performing arts programs or affordable programs in the area of student's interest

OR...

The applicant must meet the following qualifications:

- have a specially sponsored agent (agent must be approved by TCPA)
- exhibit behavior and/or academic challenges and express a desire to attend performing arts classes

**Students completing the Trinity Conservatory of Performing Arts Scholarship Application must fit one or more of the above qualifications and be willing to submit the following:**

- Ages 10-16
- Transcript with GPA 2.5 or above
- Essay (250 to 400 Word) "What are your talents and how can Trinity Conservatory of Performing Arts assist you in reaching your goals?"
- Attend an interview with the scholarship committee (date & time TBA)

All scholarship recipients will be required to participate in the following activities to maintain their scholarship awards:

### **A. Triple Threat/Full Scholarship Students**

Must enroll in and **regularly attend weekly training classes**

- acting, music, and one dance class as scheduled **OR**
- three weekly dance classes as scheduled

Maintain 2.5 or higher GPA

Submit monthly progress report (signed teacher report, Infinite Campus or official school computer printout)

Parents & student **must** participate in fundraisers (selling and/or attendance; must sign in during fundraiser events and stay for the duration)

Participate in Etiquette & Leadership Workshops as scheduled

Be an ambassador for TCPA: appear in commercials, attend community events

representing TCPA as a spokesperson, and participate in community performances

Participate in community service at Trinity Conservatory of Performing Arts 3 or more hours per month

### **B. Specially Sponsored Students**

Must enroll in and attend at least one performing arts training class as specified by the sponsoring agent

Maintain 2.5 or higher GPA

Submit monthly progress report (signed teacher report, Infinite Campus or official school computer printout)

Parent and students are encouraged to participate in scheduled fundraisers

Participate in community service as designated by sponsoring agent for 1-3 hours per month

### **C. Reach For Success Scholarship Students**

Must enroll in and **regularly attend weekly training classes**

- acting, music, media and one dance class as scheduled

Experiencing academic and/or behavior challenges

Academic achievement & behavior will be monitored through submission of monthly progress report (signed teacher report, Infinite Campus or official school computer printout)

Parents & student **must** participate in fundraisers (selling and/or attendance; must sign in during fundraiser events and stay for the duration)

Participate in Etiquette & Leadership Workshops as scheduled

Be an ambassador for TCPA: appear in commercials, attend community events

representing TCPA as a spokesperson, and participate in community performances

Participate in community service at Trinity Conservatory of Performing Arts 3 or more hours per month
